The Gallatin Conservation District announces the availability of a \$1000 scholarship in honor of long time Gallatin Conservation District board member and rancher, John Venhuizen. This scholarship is available to a graduate of the 2022 academic year from a Gallatin County High School or equivalent.

Eligibility Rules and General Information

- Scholarship will be awarded to a Gallatin County graduating student, enrolling full time in a post-secondary school.
- Graduate plans to pursue a degree related to conservation, natural resources, agriculture, or a STEAM (Science, technology, engineering, art and math) -related field.
- Students applying for the scholarship under a STEAM major must show an emphasis on natural resource studies (Forestry, wildlife management, ecology, etc.)
- Application must be completed and submitted via email, postal mail, or dropped off at Gallatin Conservation District, 120 S. 5th Street. Suite B104, Manhattan, MT.
- Scholarship recipient will be selected by GCD's board of supervisors on the basis of academic achievement, educational goals, extracurricular activities and any additional criteria as may be deemed appropriate by the board.
